7.1 President's Report: **Tom Keefe**

7.2 Plant Control/Health Dept. Report: **Tom Keefe**
Tom Keefe and Dave Tatak met with the harvesting crew: Dave Macleary, Carlos Perez, Daisy Perez and Randy Koestra (as needed) are returning. The truck has been returned and repairs were donated by Randy Koestra.

Tom reassured everyone that the ProcellaCor treatment worked on the Eurasian Milfoil. The curly leaf pondweed is currently sprouting in the lake and will die on its own in mid June. Chemically treating the curly leaf pondweed is prohibited according to the Incidental Take contract LLMA has with the IDNR. However, individual homeowners can cut or treat the curly leaf pondweed. Tom entertained questions from the audience about the weeds. It was suggested that East Loon Lake join forces to chemically treat the curly pondweed in early 2025. As a result of eliminating the Eurasian Milfoil, other native plants are coming back that will help with fishing and the health of the lakes.

7.4 Water Clarity/Lake Monitoring Report: **Roger Doss**
No report. Alaina at the health dept. is coordinating the lake monitoring program in Illinois. The lakes levels are fluctuating between 1.9 and 2.2. We have hit the highest levels within the last 4 years.

7.5 Water Level Structure Committee Report: **Matt Ashbacher**
Water level as of April 28th was 1.6. NICC did not vote on the water level structure. The committee is going to let the water levels maintain themselves.

A motion was made by Chris Pyles to establish a policy that when the water level reaches 2.7, the NO WAKE signs will be posted on both lakes. Seconded by Roger Doss. Motion was passed unanimously.
