#### 7.2.1 Plant Control Report:

Tom is working with Gerry Urbanozo at the Health Dept. to amend the IDNR Incidental Take Authorization Agreement to include the data on the endangered fish. The data lists only 4 endangered fish in the lakes. On May 15, 2025, the amended Agreement comes due for review. He will send the report to IDNR soon. We are trying to get the ITA fish survey from every 3 years to every 5 years. Also, Tom has requested permission to harvest the curly leaf pond weed early in June to help get it under control.

Dave and Tom will be meeting with Seapro, Gerry Urbanozo and Solitude to do a plant survey regarding the return of the milfoil in spots around both lakes, and a complete treatment of East Loon Lake. We are under warranty, and they will be applying ProcellaCor.

Dave Tatak attended the ILMA Conference and reported on a new invasive plant, called Hydrilla, in Illinois. It is originally from the Southern states. Alaina is heading a task force to eliminate Hydrilla.
