**7.2.1 Plant Control Report:**

Gerry and a representative from Cipro conducted a survey on August 27<sup>th</sup> based on the recurrence of the milfoil in both lakes. In order to retreat the lake, the warranty states, we can only retreat on 4 locations on East Loon Lake (map attached), and nothing on West Loon Lake.

A proposal to apply a Sonar herbicide treatment, next spring, to the milfoil and the curly leaf, to all of East Loon Lake was proposed. This would be a 3-year multiple treatment process, at a cost of \$29,000/year for both milfoil and curly leaf.

Another option would be to harvest the curly leaf in early spring. The IDNR has to approve this option in the ITA (Incidental Take Authorization).

A motion was made by Linda Musial, seconded by Matt Johnson, to honor the agreement with ProcellaCor to continue the milfoil treatment next spring to the 4 locations on East Loon Lake,. The motion was accepted.

**7.2.2 Harvester Report:**

Harvester trailer needs extensive repairs, including new axels and bearings. It would cost around \$5,000 to do repair work or replace the trailer for \$35,000 - \$40,000.

A motion was made by Dirk Danker; seconded by Joan Lahey, to put \$5,000, not exceed \$6,000, toward the repair of the trailer.

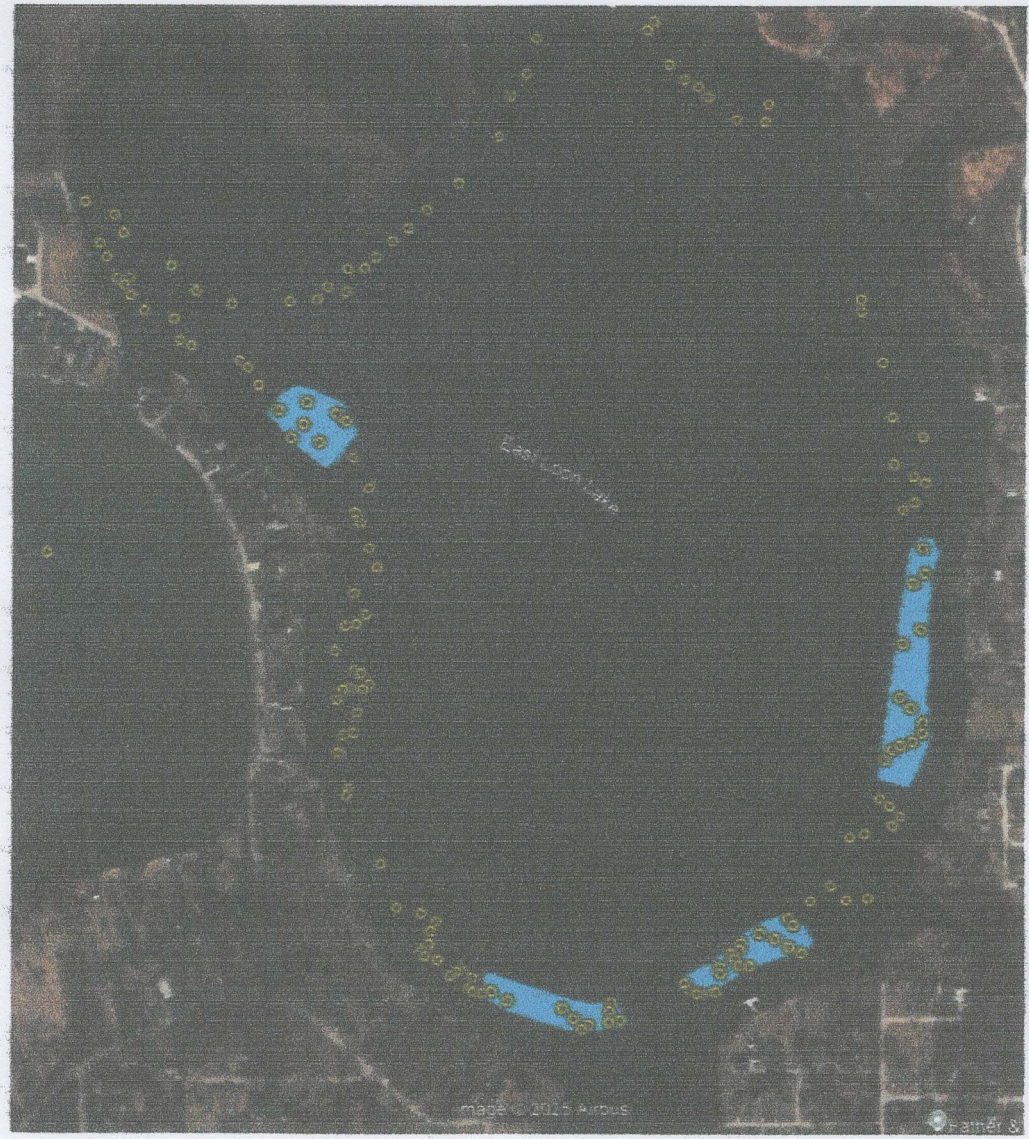
